September is filled with events and has opportunities for knowledge sharing and collaboration nationally. Please find below some of the key upcoming events and activities for the sector.

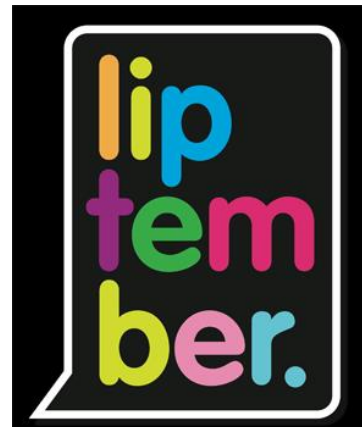
